Tuition, Timing & Other Details

FEE SCHEDULE FOR 2025/2026 ACADEMIC YEAR

Admission Fee: TZS 1,200,000 (This is a one-time non-refundable fee).

School Development Fee: TZS 1,500,000 (This is a one-time non-refundable fee)

Accreditation Fee: TZS 1,300,000 (This is paid yearly)

After School Activities: TZS 800,000 (This is paid Termly)

Tuition Fee Preschool 12 months to 3-year-old babies

Term Fees - 2 days a week: TZS 2,500,000

Term Fees - 3 days a week: TZS 3,800,000

Term Fees - 5 days a week: TZS 4,700,000

Tuition Fee Preschool and KG 3 years to 6 years

Term Fees - 5 days a week TZS 4,700,000

NB: There are three terms per year.

SCHOOL TIMINGS:

DROP OFF: Your Child may be dropped off at school as early as 7:45 am and will be under the supervision of the Bloom Helpers. The Homeroom teachers will be on playground duty from 8:00 am following their morning meeting.

The classes will begin at 8:00 am. Please maintain these hours to avoid disrupting the classes during their regular schedules.

PICK-UP: Your child must be picked up from school at the end of their class, unless the school has been notified that they will attend a stay-and-play program or a scheduled afternoon activity. Please see below for more information.

Meals & Programs

SNACKS & LUNCH

At our school, we are committed to promoting the health and well-being of our students by providing nutritious and balanced food options. To support their growth and learning, we encourage parents and guardians to opt for their kids to eat school meals instead of bringing their meals from home.

Snack Guidelines

The school shall provide healthy snacks for snack time and mid-afternoon time for students who stay for after-school activities.

Healthy Choices: We select snacks that are rich in vitamins, minerals, and fibre. Such as

- Fresh fruit (such as apple slices, bananas, grapes, berries)
- Vegetables (like carrot sticks, cucumber slices, cherry tomatoes) paired with hummus or yoghurt dip
- Whole grain crackers or rice cakes
- Low-fat cheese or yoghurt
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Foods we Limit or Avoid: At the school, we advocate for healthy living standards and therefore we avoid snacks that are high in sugar, salt, or artificial additives, such as:-

- Candy
- Oily food
- Sugary granola bars

Portion Control: Snacks will be given in a manageable portion, enough for the child, to encourage independence and ensure ease of consumption.

Our Lunch Guidelines

Balanced Meal:

A well-balanced lunch that includes:

- A source of protein (lean meats, beans, or legumes)
- Whole grains (brown rice, whole grain bread, or pasta)
- A variety of colourful vegetables (salad, steamed veggies, or veggie wraps)
- A serving of fruit for dessert



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Hydration: We encourage hydration by providing water, milk, or fresh fruit juices. We strictly prohibit sugary canned drinks such as sodas and artificial soft drinks

Easy to Eat: We ensure that food is cut into small, manageable pieces to facilitate self-feeding and promote independence. We avoid foods that are too messy or difficult to eat.

Mealtime and Presentation

The school serves food on light silicone plates designed for children. We also encourage the use of reusable water bottles instead of one-time bottles in order to care for the environment. Soft silicone spoons and forks will be provided to ensure safety and ease of use. For safety reasons, we discourage the use of metallic cutlery and chopsticks

Variety: The school ensures that children get a variety of food to develop a taste for healthy options.

Additional Tips

We Involve Children: Sometimes we encourage children to help choose and prepare their snacks and lunches. This can foster positive attitudes toward healthy eating. This will be done once a week and is meant to expose children to the food preparation process.

Communicate Allergies: If your child has food allergies or dietary restrictions, please communicate this clearly to our staff to ensure their safety.

Please note that students are not permitted to bring their meals. Therefore, kindly do not pack food for your child.

STAY & PLAY PROGRAM

You may choose for your child to stay back after school under supervised care till 4:30 pm. We shall set up a range of different activities for children and ensure that they are fed, cared for and safe.

There will always be one teacher on afternoon duty with assistants. You may be required to send in a packed lunch in the morning or drop it off in the afternoon by 1:00 pm (we have the facilities for storing and heating meals), an extra pair of clothes, diapers & wipes (if applicable)

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AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITY PROGRAM:

Our after-school activity programs are run by professional teachers and are open to the general public. Each program will vary by age and cost. We shall update our program termly and try to cater for special requests. All registered children are supposed to attend at least 2 activities per term. After-school activities take place from 2:40 pm - 3:40 pm.

Fee Policy

SCHOOL FEES

1. All school fees are based on Tanzanian Shillings and subject to change
2. The full school fees for the following term must be paid by the fee deadlines. You will receive a reminder with the fee deadline for the full school calendar year
3. Payments can be made in the following ways
 - a) Cheque paid to Brianiac Bloom International Schools LTD
 - b) Bank deposits
 - c) Wire transfer
 - d) Credit card payment

N.B. We do not accept cash payments at the school

4. Payments made in foreign currency are converted into Shillings at the medium rate of the Bank of Tanzania.
5. All dishonoured cheques will incur a fee of TZS 50,000 and late payment penalties, in addition to all bank charges levied against the drawer
6. You will be required to settle the fees for the next term as per the fees deadlines, even if your child started in between the terms.
7. If you/your family are planning to travel, please ensure that you have settled the school fees for the following term beforehand. The school will not accept this as a reason for unpaid/late fees, and you will be required to settle the late fees or apply for readmission. If you are unsure of your registration status, please communicate with the school.
8. The office will send you one reminder after the fee deadline, and you will be expected to settle the fees immediately.
9. In case the fees are not settled within the first week of the school term, your child will lose his/her space and you will have to reapply for admission if the space is available and with no guarantee of the space.



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REFUND POLICY

- 1) Registration fees, once paid, are non-refundable
- 2) Term fees will be refunded only in case the child will not be joining that term and the school has been notified in writing one month before the commencement of the term.

Note: Term fees are non-refundable once the term has already started, irrespective of the number of days the child has attended the school

- 3) In special circumstances, we may need a therapist to deal with children with Special Education Needs. The parent will be notified and, after taking the necessary steps, the Individualised therapy plan will be created, and the parent will be required to pay additional TZS 1,000,000 per term to cover the costs.
- 4) The management reserves the right to suspend or withdraw a child's place over nonpayment of fees.
